What are the In-Lieu Fees?

- Fees to offset development impacts in kit fox range
- Collected by planning and building departments
- Held by the Nature Conservancy
- Funds administered by CDFW
- Funds generally granted to NGOs for habitat acquisition and permanent conservation



Summary of Results 2012-2024

- 13 property acquisitions
- 1,960 acres acquired
- 2.46M Spent—almost all on property
- \$70K on stewardship (e.g. boundary fencing)
- (Since inception, \$3.9M generated)
